評価基準及び評価手段・万法の補足説明

Students are expected to actively attend all classes. Homework is required to be completed by dates specified by the instructor. Homework requires access to the internet and the use of a computer or tablet or mobile device. Students will receive regular feedback online and individualized feedback in-person on tests and projects. Mid-term and Final examinations may include both listening-based tests with a focus on grammar and vocabulary, as well as conversation tests.
