An initial objective of this course is to learn and understand the course for the rise of the world oldest nation-states in the Ancient Orient and the rise of the Aegean civilization in the eastern Mediterranean. Then, a topic of the course is to be turned around and attention is to be focused on pre-historic Japan in periods after arrival of Homo sapiens. Those periods to be dealt with are the Jyomon, Yayoi and Kofun periods.
