Pre-lecture quizzes to be given to check students' understanding of the study chapter each week (10%). Review questions will be given to further students' comprehension of studied content (10%). Quizzes will be given to check whether students are able to explain basic terms of International Relations (10%). Students will be asked to give a presentation (10%) on a topic concerning Japan's recent international relations. Feedback will be given when answer to the questions and quiz are handed back, and at the end of presentation week. A final exam will be given to check students' understanding of the IR terms, as well as that of Japan's international relations (60%).							
授業の概要							
This course consists of three parts, a brief history of modern international relations, basics of international relations theory, and a group presentation. Students will choose a country of her/his interest, and report the history of interactions between that country and Japan. この授業の標準的な1コマあたりの授業外学修時間は、180分とする。
