授業の概要							
This class introduces students to studying in an overseas classroom. Students will listen to short lectures, take notes, and discuss a variety of topics. Class time will focus on basic listening and discussion skills with the overall aim of becoming a Global Person. Extensive outside-of-class vocabulary study and weekly quizzes are key aspects of this course. Additional IELTS practice exercises are also assigned periodically.
